A Brief History **1UNETEENTH**

pays tribute to the official announcement of the abolition of slavery in Texas by Union General Gordon Granger (and 2,000 federal troops) in 1865--nearly 3 years after Abraham Lincoln had declared all slaves be freed. In 1872, Freeman's town residents Jack Yates, Elias Dibble, Richard Allen & Richard Brock purchased 10 acres at Dowling & Elgin and dedicated "Emancipation Park" as a place to celebrate Juneteenth.

In 1973, C. Anderson Davis, founder of The National Emancipation Association, initiated Houston's Juneteenth Parade. In 1979, State Representative AI Edwards sponsored the bill that made June 19th a Texas State holiday beginning in 1980. In 1973, C.
